The October meeting at the Park Plaza Hotel was the first for new president Earl D. Allen,

who introduced Mr. R.M. Dillion, Ontario Deputy Minister of Energy as the speaker, who talked about the recently announced Energy Development Corporation, energy policy and resource conservation

November had "The Efficient Use of Energy Through Infa-Red" as the subject and the speaker was Mr. Joseph W. Adams P.Eng., of Bettcher Manufacturing of Cleveland, Ohio. Mr. Adams pointed out the seriousness of the energy situation in the United States where the population represents only 6% of world population but uses 33% of the energy used in the world. He indicated that the infa-red is one of the most efficient heating systems available, and how it could be applied to design projects.

December at the Park Plaza Hotel was pleased to offer Mr. Gilbert F. Carlson, Director of Technical Services, ITT Bell and Gossett, who spoke on the subject "Pump Energy Savings for Hydronic Systems". Mr. Carlson explained in detail how the pumping power requirements for any system are fundamentally determined.

The start of a new calendar year had Barry Van Camp, President of Van Camp Products and Sales Limited, who presented a paper on the chemical treatment needed for your building systems and how to determine what you need.
